

A single gang version adaptor box is also available. Please note: This instruction sheet demonstrates installing a double gang unit. These instructions can also be applied to installing the single gang version!



Mounting Options



Flush Mount Standoff Ring Mount (Double Gang Box Only!)

- For **Standoff Ring Mounting** leave Faceplate and Standoff Ring attached! - or -
- For Flush Mounting and for Adapter Box Mounting remove Standoff Ring!

To release Standoff Ring, insert small screwdriver tip in slot in top of Faceplate and push straight down (two places). **Swing** Faceplate outward.

2. Flush Or Standoff Ring **Mount Installations**

2.1 Attach plate to double gang electrical box or plaster ring.






3. Installing a MediaFlex Adapter Box

3.1 To accommodate cables routed from inside the wall, push electrical box or plaster ring. out and break off center panels.








3.3 Using cutters and a knife, remove side tabs to suit the size and direction of any surface mounted cables or raceway.

3.4 Snap adapter box onto backplate.


3.5 Snap faceplate onto front of the adapter box.

remove any sharp edges from the openings.




4. Removing Faceplate and Adapter Box

3.6 Connect required components. small screwdriver tip in slot in (ref. 2.2) top of faceplate and push straight down (two places).



4.1 To release faceplate, insert **4.2** To separate adapter box from backplate, insert small screwdriver tip in slot between backplate and box. Lever toward the center of the box (four places). Pull adapter box outward.
